Outline & Achievements:

- Employed on an interim basis to replace the Procurement Manager & Stores Manager, following a forced restructure. Supporting existing employees & stabilising control.
- Improve availability & stock accuracy, focusing on incorrect stock levels, & incorrect specifications (*Investigatory stock take proved 54% accuracy on system inventory, versus actual shelf stock*).
- To confirm current state of inventory, prove reliability of control, validity of data, & the implementation of KPI's reference stock movement / stock levels.
- Review, validate, & improve: Receipt → Put Away → Traceability → Pick Accuracy → Delivery Performance (*Establishing Performance, Measuring Failure, & Applying New Standards*)
- Review & improve procurement process, focusing primarily on; quality, specification / suitability, delivery, lead times, UOM, & cost.

Reviewing & resolving:

- slow / obsolete stock items (*example: returned 152 SKU Lines back to supplier, recouping \$314k of material costs*)
- Calibrated tool control (receipt → issue → returns)
- Poor control on consumable stock items (*eventually improved through BOM review*)
- Contract extended on 3 occasions, with an offer of a full-time appointment at the end of assignment

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- Improved stock / cycle count from **54%** accuracy to a consistent **99.9%** within 4 months
